## Alazani Saperavi Red 2018



## Producer

A family run winery, currently run by 2nd and 3rd generation - Simon and Daniil Nadashvili. Alazani is located in a village called Kardenakhi. Kardenakhi has a long winemaking history, every house/door had a vine growing over it and that's where the name comes from - `Kari` (door) and `Venakhi` (vine) - `Kardenakhi`. Alazani makes wines in both the traditional `qvevri` way and more modern international winemaking styles.

## **Tasting Notes**

Saperavi is a teinturier grape, which means that both the flesh and the skins of the grape are red, the name Saperavi translates as `to dye`. This gives the wine a rich, deep colour with a pronounced black fruit nose. The palate is round with brambles, black cherries and rich, chewy tannins.

## Food

Serve with lamb or beef dishes and can stand up to reasonably spiced dishes such as a rogan josh.
