

# Beaujolais Villages Glou Glou Gamay Jean Baptiste Duperray 2022



## Region

The vineyards of Beaujolais fall on the granite rich slopes of a hilly region between Mâcon and Lyon at the southern limit of Burgundy. The only vine variety authorised for red wines is Gamay, traditionally grown as free standing bush vines. A small amount of Chardonnay is also grown. The most favourable vineyard sites produce 'villages' wines, and the 10 named 'Cru' villages of Beaujolais represent the best vineyards of the region and produce the longest-lived and fullest style of Beaujolais.

## Producer

Located in the south of Beaujolais, Jean-Baptiste joined his father in 2013 to work in their estate. They work together and share their points of view to create well balanced wines. Jean-Baptiste states that he believes in their grape variety, Gamay, which is ideal for fruity and fresh wines. They are HVE certified and practice a sustainable farming.

## Tasting Notes

Glou Glou is a Beaujolais Villages wine, 100% Gamay made without the addition of any additives and aged in cement vats for five months. The result is a pure expression of the grape; juicy red cherries and raspberries combine with a touch of spice creating an easy drinking, juicy red wine.

## Food

Perfect when paired with French pate or dry cured meats. Try lightly chilling in summer.
