

Morey St Denis 1er Cru Charrieres, Michelot 2020



Region

The Côte de Nuits follows a narrow strip of red iron-rich soils that run the short distance south from Dijon to the town of Nuits St Georges and ends before the hill of Corton. It is perhaps the source of the greatest and most elusive Pinot Noir wines of Burgundy. To travel through this northern half of the Côte d'Or evokes a role call of great vineyard names; Gevrey, Vosne Romanée, Clos de Vougeot, Musigny, Nuits St Georges and more. Here in the Côte de Nuits the best vineyards lie along a narrow band of limestone slopes facing south-east to maximise exposure to the sun. Lower-lying vineyards with more clay drain less well and tend to produce less exciting wine.

Producer

Vigneron and bon viveur Alain Michelot has tended his vines with immaculate and loving care since inheriting the estate in 1966 at a young age after the untimely passing of his father. The Domaine, which dates back to around 1880, owns approximately 20 acres of vineyards and the majority are on the slopes overlooking his home town of Nuits St Georges. The beautiful winery is located in the centre and today with help from his talented daughter Elodie they have quietly re-invested in new tanks and winemaking equipment reinforcing their long standing commitment to quality. Tasting Notes

Domaine Alain Michelot's Morey-Saint-Denis 1er Cru offers an elegant and finely structured expression of Pinot Noir. Aromas of ripe black cherry, raspberry and wild strawberry lead into subtle floral, earthy and spicy nuances. The palate is beautifully balanced, combining silky tannins with fresh acidity and concentrated red and dark fruit. Hints of forest floor, violet and gentle oak add complexity, while the finish is long, savoury and refined, with the freshness and precision characteristic of Morey-Saint-Denis.

Food

This is a powerful Pinot Noir which needs strong flavoured meat like pheasant, game or veal.
