Region

The biggest and most important of Argentina's wine regions, Mendoza includes a wide variety of altitudes and micro-climates to allow a huge range of wine styles. The main vineyard area is at the base of the Andes in the valley of the Mendoza River, with vineyards ranging from 500-1500 metres above sea level. Many early winemakers were of Italian origin and brought with them their native Barbera, Bonarda and Sangiovese. However, it is Malbec, originally from Bordeaux and the southwest of France, that has established the most successful presence in Mendoza.

Producer

These wines have been specifically chosen for Ellis by our team of buyers. The focus of this range is to create high quality wines which capture the quintessential characteristics of varieties from around the winemaking world. As sustainability is something very close to our hearts here at Ellis, these wines have been shipped in the most environmentally friendly way and bottled at a carbon minus bottling facility.

Tasting Notes

This Malbec is grown using organic principles in the vineyards of Mendoza. A great example of a classic Argentinian Malbec. Deep dark purple in colour with bramble fruits and black cherries on the nose. The palate has great concentration of intense dark fruits such as black cherries and plums and blackberry jam in addition to rich notes of chocolate on the finish. The wine has a full body with a velvety texture for a long-lasting feel in your mouth of the forest fruits and spice.

Serve with steaks, BBQ foods and cured meats.
