

Chassagne Montrachet Village`Les Chaumes` Rouge Domaine Morey Coffinet 2022



Region

Some of the most prestigious white wines in Burgundy, and indeed the world, are made in Chassagne Montrachet. The Grand Cru of Criots-Bâtard-Montrachet is in Chassagne, whilst it shares the Grand Crus of Le Montrachet and Bâtard-Montrachet with its neighbour Puligny. Unlike Puligny, a sizeable proportion of Chassagne's vineyards are planted with Pinot Noir and whilst never reaching the dizzying heights of the whites, is often quite charming and pretty. The soils around the commune have a high content of limestone. It is this limestone structure that is essential for the creation of some of the worlds most respected Chardonnay.

Tasting Notes

From young Pinot Noir vines planted in 2008 on the `Les Chaumes` plot on the beginning of the hillside on clay and limestone soils. Aged in barrels for 13 months. Scented pure red fruit, an aromatic, healthy, mineral palate, focused, tensile. Good red fruit and wet stone finish. Fresh and finessed with good vibrancy and energy.

Food

Game birds including woodpigeon, quail and pheasant or simple Bourgogne boeuf and lamb dishes will work well.
