

St Julien Ch Lagrange Les Fiefs de Lagrange 2015



Producer

The Chateau Lagrange we know today dates back to the 18th century although the land has been utilised for a much longer period. It is reputed to have been home to an order of the Knights Templar in the early 14th century but was given to the De Cours family when the sect dissolved. In recent years, considerable investment has resulted in the estate enjoying huge success. Les Fiefs de Lagrange is the second wine of the estate with only 31000 cases made.

Tasting Notes

Second wine of Chateau Lagrange, combines great purity, tangy acidity and depth of fruit of the vintage with the slightly more forward style of a serious second label. The bouquet is deep, focused and classy. This is simply a terrific second label from one of the most traditional, and hence important chateau remaining in St. Julien.

Serve with pot roasted pheasant or Beef Wellington.
