

Ch. Grand Puy Lacoste 5me Cru Classe 2018



Region

Pauillac is renowned for being a source of quality Bordeaux wines, sitting on the left side of the Gironde River on the gravel beds. Here the vines have ideal drainage and riverside micro-climate enjoyed by the dominant varietal, Cabernet Sauvignon. Here the expression is richly concentrated blackcurrant and exotic, smoky fruit, which is softened with some Merlot and has added complexity with the minute addition of the dark inky Petit Verdot. Wines from Pauillac are known for their structure and concentration with great potential for ageing.

Tasting Notes

Château Grand-Puy-Lacoste displays the classic elegance and structure of Pauillac, with expressive aromas of blackcurrant, blackberry and dark plum complemented by cedar, graphite and subtle tobacco. The palate is beautifully balanced, combining concentrated dark fruit with fine-grained tannins and fresh acidity. Hints of pencil lead, spice and earthy complexity develop through the long, persistent finish. Powerful yet refined, with excellent precision and depth, this is a quintessential Pauillac that combines Cabernet Sauvignon-driven character with a sophisticated, age-worthy structure.

Pair with fine cuts of beef, roast lamb, duck or a rich mushroom risotto.
