

Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Chenevottes Domaine Gerard Thomas 2020



Producer

Gerard Thomas has been running this Saint-Aubin based estate since 1982 and is now helped by his two daughters, Isabelle and Anne in both viticulture and winemaking. After expanding the domaine in Cotes de Beaune, acquiring vineyards within premium locations such as Chassagne and Puligny Montrachet, the estate now holds 12 hectares of vines within the Cote d'Or.

Tasting Notes

This Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru has been fermented in French barrels of which 25% is new. 10 months in cask follows, with regular lees stirring for complexity. Intense on the nose with aromas of lemon citrus and green apple with smoky, toasted oak. Rich, round and generous on the palate with impressive concentration of further citrus and white stone fruit supported by bright, vibrant acidity which gives the wine a beautiful balance. The rich flavours linger on the finish.

Food

Pairs perfectly with rich fish dishes like sea bass, turbot or monkfish. Also with roast chicken.
