

Crazy Bulles Sparkling Rose 2024



Region

Méditerranée is an IGP title covering wines that are produced in a large area on the southeast coast of France, roughly corresponding to the Provence wine region but also includes a part of the Rhône Valley. The IGP shares its land with multiple AOC appellations as varied as Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Bandol and Côtes de Provence. It can broadly be described as having a warm Mediterranean climate, ideal for growing healthy ripe grapes.

Producer

Domaine Tropez was born in 1996 and since then it has assembled a number of AOC Cotes de Provence vines, covering over 40 hectares. Domaine Tropez wines are bright and lively as a result of the strong influence of the clay and limestone soils along with the Mediterranean climate. The vineyard has undergone major reconstruction calling for a large investment to build a state-of-the-art wine cellar. In 2020, they were officially certified sustainable, and they continue to work with organic practices.

Tasting Notes

Pale pink colour with rose gold reflects. Charms the nose with floral red fruit aromas and citrus. A mouth filling fine sparkles cascade across the palate with generous flavours of berries and tangerine zest. Refreshing, with a finish full of finesse.

Food

Delightful as an aperitif or would pair well with seafood and salad dishes.
