

# La Vigneau Cinsault Rose, Languedoc 2022



## Region

The Languedoc is a vast region stretching across much of the south and Mediterranean with large volume of IGP wine within the distinct areas of l'Aude, Gard and Hérault and also well known appellations such as Minervois, Corbières, Pic Saint Loup and Fitou. It's history dates back to the Greeks and Romans as well as monasteries in the Middle Ages. The Languedoc experiences Mediterranean climate with high levels of sunshine and warmth with low rainfall which are all favourable for grape growing. A wide range of grape varieties are grown including Syrah, Grenache and Carignan and the local variety piquepoul making a range of styles of red, white and rosé wines.

## Producer

LGI were created in 1999 by forward thinking partners aware of the challenge and opportunity that lay ahead for regional French wines in the competitive international market. Wines are made and blended from three main sources. Saint Chinian in the Hérault, Jean d'Alibert in Minervois and from Gascogne. In the heart of the Languedoc, one of the world's largest wine regions with an array of diverse climates and terroirs allowing a range of local and international varieties to be grown.

## Tasting Notes

This modern, dry rosé from the Languedoc is wonderfully characterful. Well-made using protective techniques such as harvesting at night when it is cooler and treating the grapes carefully to preserve their freshness and expressive character. A beautiful coral pink colour which leads to an inviting bouquet of wild raspberry and candied strawberry. The palate is lively, bursting with summer fruits such as strawberry, raspberry and cherry, with a mouth filling creamy texture. It is bright and fresh with a light and mineral finish. Eminently drinkable with a subtle balancing acidity.

## Food

A delicious aperitif wine and perfect for al fresco picnics or barbecues and to match light pasta dishes, seafood salads, fish soups or mildly spiced oriental cuisine.
